

O-SHOT® [ORGASM SHOT®] WITH NATURAL PRP [PLATELET RICH PLASMA]

O-Shot is a revolutionary approach to improve sexual relations and stress urinary continence. The results of this 30 minute procedure can be life-changing for many women who report significant improvement in stimulation, sensitivity, arousal, orgasm and libido.

O-Shot can also produce significant response even cure in some cases for urinary stress incontinence which can be extremely troubling, embarrassing, preventing engaging in healthy lifestyle activities. Better sexual pleasure can make better relationships and improve self-esteem.

PRP – PLATELET RICH PLASMA

is used extensively and safely world-wide for repairing injured or ageing tissues in regenerative orthopaedic work and even more so in cosmetic rejuvenation hence the logical use for sexual and genital rejuvenation.

New tissues grow when the PRP is activated with calcium:

This extra calcium chloride triggers the platelets to release at least 7 different growth factors that then trigger stem cells to come into the area to grow younger tissue--activating [unipotent stem cells](#). The doctor injects the PRP into an area called the [O-Spot--a collection of structures that activate the orgasm system](#). The woman usually enjoys the effects of the O-Shot™ sometimes immediately as the growth factors begin to rejuvenate and enhance the sexual response. So, the O-Shot® (or Orgasm Shot®) is a nonsurgical procedure that uses the growth factors each woman has in her own body to stimulate vaginal and clitoral rejuvenation to activate the Female Orgasm System. Thus far, almost all women receiving O-Shot™ procedure enjoy an increase in their sexual response, and for many the increase is dramatic.

WHAT IS THE O-SHOT ?

The Orgasm Shot® (O-Shot®) procedure is a very specific method of using blood-derived growth factors [in PRP – platelet rich plasma] carefully injected to rejuvenate the vagina to help relieve women with urinary incontinence and sexual problems. The names "Orgasm Shot" and "O-Shot" were awarded to Charles Runels, MD (the first to do the procedure) and are protected by US Patent & Trademark law. Only properly trained, accredited doctors are certified to do this procedure.

FEMALE SEXUAL DISORDERS

What is not realised by many women that they may actually have a medical condition to explain their problem. For some men and women there are psychological reasons, but what if that was not the case, and a treatment was possible?

HERE ARE 5 SEX-PLEASURE CONDITIONS:

FEMALE SEXUAL AROUSAL DISORDER (usually but not always accompanies Sexual Desire Disorder). Women who suffer with this may want to have sex but have much difficulty finding the pleasure of arousal. The 5% incidence doesn't sound like much until you think about it--that's the same as one in 20!

HYPOACTIVE SEXUAL DESIRE DISORDER (Low desire). Remember, that this is not counted a disorder unless it's disrupting the woman's life. Around 10% of women suffer with this problem. Important: Suffering with a sexual disorder does not simply make sex not fun. Better sex leads to more energy, more creativity, increased confidence, less depression, and improved overall health.

FEMALE ORGASMIC DISORDER: Again around 1 in 20 (or 5%). Here women can become aroused but have much difficulty with orgasm. This can be so frustrating that sex becomes a frustration that they avoid.

DYSPAREUNIA: Here the woman suffers with real pain with sex (not from decreased lubrication or vaginal spasm). The incidence is from around 1 in 10 to 1 in 5 women. (The above shocking statistics came from Obstetrics & Gynecology April 2011)

GENITAL MISMATCH can contribute to both Female Orgasmic Disorder & to Dyspareunia

THE O-SHOT PROCEDURE – IN BRIEF:

- The O-Shot procedure explained, any questions answered.
- Medical History taken
- Relevant health examination but not including gynaecological – that's for your GP or gynaecologist.
- Consent forms completed and signed.
- Small amount of blood collected (like a blood test). It is placed in a centrifuge and the separated serum containing the PRP removed. The PRP is activated with calcium to make it even more potent.
- You have numbing cream applied so the procedure is painless or with minimal discomfort.
- The O-Shot serum PRP is then precisely injected with a fine needle into the very numbed upper area of the vagina where the 'Orgasm Spot' is located and also the clitoral area.
- Normal activities can follow as soon as the numbness wears off.
- No serious side effects have been encountered from using the body's own serum in over 500,000 PRP procedures world-wide.
- For most cases the procedure should be repeated 3 months later.

HOW LONG BEFORE RESULTS ARE SEEN?

In some cases it can be same day, but in general over the next few weeks.

DO I NEED MORE INJECTIONS?

It is highly recommended to repeat the procedure in 3 months.

IS THE O-SHOT GUARANTEED TO WORK?

There is a very high percentage success with O-Shot, but for complex reasons some women may not experience success such is the variation of the human for medical matters.
